I am writing to invite you to become a follow-up provider for Utah's Well-integrated Screening and Evaluation for Women-Across the Nation (WISEWOMAN) Program, known in Utah as the BeWise Program. As a health care provider you would deliver diagnostic and follow-up care to clients with abnormal cardiovascular screening values.

The BeWise program provides mid- to low-income, underinsured or uninsured 40-64 year old women with the knowledge, skills and opportunities to improve their diet, physical activity, and other life habits to prevent, delay, or control cardiovascular and other chronic diseases. The preventive health services offered include the following: blood pressure, cholesterol, and glucose testing; A1C testing; risk reduction counseling; individual lifestyle coaching, and referral for abnormal clinical findings

To become a follow-up provider for the BeWise Program simply complete, sign, and return the attached *Clinic Provider Agreement* form to the program.
